The department of civil aviation has signed an agreement with Folga Denber to operate transit cargo flights for the UN through RAK International Airport, which states providing of all ground services, fuel and food for the giant cargo aircraft owned by the company” announced Mohammad Al Khuder, Manager of Department of Civil Aviation and member of Economical Committee of the Airports Board (ACI).

The manager said that Folga Denber has chosen RAK Airport as a transit point for the purpose of supplying fuel and providing ground services. The cargo company will route 10 to 15 flights through RAK Airport, where such aircrafts demand special arrangements for its parking and ground services.

These cargo aircrafts are type ANTANOOF 124 with capacity of 129 tons and will operate two flights a day.

The manager of the Civil Aviation Department has stated that the ANTANOOF 124 is class E as per ICAO classification where the fire and safety department raise their capabilities to the 10th grade to handle such aircrafts.
