RAK International Airport is receiving the KAM AIR Afghani Aircrafts which will transport Afghanies going to Hajj in Mecca in Saudi Arabia.

KAM AIR has signed a deal with RAK International Airport for providing all the needed ground services for the flight which will take the route Ghandahar - RAK - Jeddah. All flights will land in RAK which will act as a transit point for refuelling and supplies.

The PR department of the airport has confirmed that KAM AIR will starts its flights from RAK airport with 6 flights daily transporting 1000 passengers via aircraft 727, 737, MD82, MD83. This agreement will further raise the percentage of passengers at RAK international Airport this year.
